Possible Rules Governing Radon Control Methods in Residential Buildings, Minnesota Rules, parts 1303.2400 to 1303.2403 and Adoption of the 2012 International Energy Conservation Code Residential Provisions, Minnesota Rules, Chapter 1322, R-04141					
Subject matter	<p>The Department of Labor and Industry is proposing amendments to the radon control methods rule based on the 2012 edition of the International Residential Code (Appendix F) as model language, with necessary amendments, and any other rules to administer and enforce the code requirements for radon control methods. The proposed amendments move the radon control methods rule from chapter 1322 to chapter 1303.</p> <p>The Department of Labor and Industry is also proposing amendments that incorporate by reference the residential provisions of the 2012 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code, with amendments, and any other amendments necessary to administer and enforce the code for residential energy conservation. The proposed amendments update the existing Minnesota Residential Energy Code in chapter 1322.</p>
